February is National Children's Dental Health Month

National Children's Dental Health Month (NCDHM) is going on now and aims to "promote the benefits of good oral health to children, their caregivers, teachers and many others." Every February, the American Dental Association (ADA) sponsors NCDHM to raise awareness about the importance of oral health.

This year's NCDHM campaign slogan is "Brush and clean in between to build a healthy smile." The ADA offers <u>downloadable flyers and posters</u>, as well as planning guides and activity sheets.

In line with NCDHM's mission, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Dental Transformation Initiative (DTI) further represents a critical mechanism to improve dental health for children. DTI provides up to \$750 million of additional funds over five years with the goals to improve the oral health of children enrolled in the Medi-Cal Dental Program. This includes increasing the use of preventive dental services and oral health disease management for children, expanding prevention and risk assessment models focused on preventing and treating early childhood caries, and increasing continuity of care for children.

Enrollment Assistance by Phone or Onsite

The Medi-Cal Dental Program offers scheduled, one-on-one enrollment assistance to providers interested in becoming a Medi-Cal dental Fee-for-Service (FFS) provider. <u>Dental Enrollment Application On-Sites</u> are intended to assist dental providers with the completion of their Medi-Cal Dental Enrollment Application Package. Those who are interested may <u>register online</u> and a representative will contact you to schedule a convenient time to meet at your office.
