## New Diagnostic Cast Submission Requirement

To improve processing times and avoid delays, providers must mail diagnostic casts to Medi-Cal Dental **10 business days** prior to mailing Treatment Authorization Requests (TARs) or Resubmission Turnaround Documents (RTDs). Diagnostic casts (procedure D0470) are required documentation for all handicapping malocclusion treatment plan requests. If a diagnostic cast is submitted late or mailed with the TAR, processing delays will occur and may cause erroneous denials for orthodontic cases.

#### Do's:

- Label diagnostic casts with:
  - Member Name
  - ° Member ID
  - ° Billing Provider Name
  - Billing Provider National Provider Identifier (NPI)
  - ° Centric occlusion marked on cast
- Dry, trim, and pack diagnostic casts carefully
- Mail diagnostic casts to the address on TAR or RTD form
- Mail diagnostic casts separately from TARs or RTDs and 10 business days prior to mailing the TAR or RTD form

#### Don'ts:

- Wet diagnostic casts
- Lock bite registration into diagnostic cast teeth
- Mail diagnostic cast to street address

- Mail TAR, RTD, or Handicapping Labio-Lingual Deviation (HLD) Index forms in the diagnostic cast box
- Write the rendering provider's Dental License Number on the diagnostic cast

# Medi-Cal Dental Billing Materials Update

Provider billing and informational notices are being updated to align with the Medi-Cal Dental terminology and logo as published in the August 2019 Provider Bulletin (<u>Volume 35, Number 26</u>).

Over the next few months, providers will see a logo and name change on the following materials:

- Billing forms (Treatment Authorization Request (TAR)/claim, Notice of Authorization (NOA), Resubmission Turnaround Document (RTD), etc.)
- Explanation of Benefits (EOBs)
- Envelopes
- Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) labels

#### These changes will not impact the Program's policy or criteria.

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### Medi-Cal Dental to Implement Current Dental Terminology 2019

The Medi-Cal Dental Program is working diligently to update its Current Dental Terminology (CDT) code set from CDT-13 to CDT-19. This update is scheduled to implement in the spring of 2020 and more information will be provided as the release date draws closer.

### Outdated Versions of Treatment Authorization Request (TAR)/Claim Forms No Longer Accepted

Medi-Cal Dental is decommissioning outdated versions of the Treatment Authorization Request (TAR)/Claim form. **Effective January 30, 2020**, providers must use a current version of the TAR/Claim form when submitting to Medi-Cal Dental. The current TAR/Claim form numbers and revision dates are:

- DC -202 (R 08/13) and (R 10/19) for filling in by hand
- DC-209 (R 07/13) and (R 10/19) for pin-fed printers
- DC-217 (R 9/13) and (R 10/19) for laser printers

Providers can confirm that they are using the most current version by checking the revision date at the bottom of the form. If you have outdated TAR/Claim forms in your dental office, please recycle the old forms and reorder new ones.

To order current TAR/Claim forms, please complete and send the Forms Reorder Request form to Medi-Cal Dental. Providers can find the Forms Reorder Request form on the Medi-Cal Dental website <u>here</u>.
