## NEW Treating Young Kids Everyday (TYKE) Course Coupon Code Available Now Through December 31, 2022

As of December 1, 2021, the California Dental Association (CDA) began charging non-CDA members \$200 to take the Treating Young Kids Everyday (TYKE) course and receive the associated Continuing Education (CE) credits.

If you are a Medi-Cal provider who is not a CDA member and need to take the TYKE course to participate in California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal (CalAIM), please use the 2022 coupon code **TYKEDHCS22**. This code is valid **through December 31, 2022** and enables you to complete the TYKE course at no cost. Please click the link [here](#) to access the training.

## CalAIM Attestation Form Requirements

**Effective February 1, 2022**, providers must use the [California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal \(CalAIM\) attestation form](#) to submit proof that the required Treating Young Kids Everyday (TYKE) training is complete. As the Dental Transformation Initiative (DTI) concluded on December 31, 2021, the DTI attestation form will not be accepted after **January 31, 2022**.

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**Please note:** DTI-participating providers who have record of completing the TYKE training for the DTI Domain 2 pilot project are not required to retake the TYKE training for CalAIM and do not need to submit a CalAIM attestation form. However, existing providers are encouraged to review the [CalAIM initiative](#) as the benefits and applicable populations have changed.

The TYKE training is a requirement of the Caries Risk Assessment (CRA) bundle, one of two new benefits added as part of the CalAIM initiative. The CRA bundle includes a CRA exam (D0601, D0602, D0603) and nutritional counseling (D1310) based on the risk level associated for members ages **0-6 only**.

### CRA Bundle Fee Schedule

To receive payment for the CRA bundle, providers must:

- » Take the [TYKE training](#) using discount code **TYKEDHCS22** for Medi-Cal providers to avoid training fees.
- » Complete the [CalAIM attestation form](#) (DTI participating providers do not need to submit CalAIM attestation).
- » Provide proof of TYKE course completion (DTI participating providers who have record of taking TYKE course do not need to provide proof).
