End of the PHE Continuous Coverage Requirement

In March 2020, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) temporarily waived certain Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) requirements and conditions in response to COVID-19. The easing of these rules helped people with Medicaid (Medi-Cal in California) and CHIP-in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and the five U.S. territories keep their health coverage during the pandemic. However, this ended on March 31, 2023 and required states to restart eligibility renewals beginning April 1, 2023.

Counties will mail members a letter about their Medi-Cal eligibility, and they will need to complete a renewal form. It is important to communicate with Medi-Cal Dental Program members to encourage them to update their contact information with their local county offices and health plans to ensure they receive important information and updates about their health coverage.
